







What is Hiring for Hope?

Hiring for Hope is a grassroots, nationally recognized 501(c)3 public charity with an active presence in international social media and physical communities across the United States. Hiring for Hope was formed in July of 2009, we received our 501(c)3 status in late June of 2010, and subsequently launched our website and opened our doors for business on September 01, 2010.

Think of Hiring for Hope as a Life Management Community (LMC) designed to help individuals manage and overcome all the obstacles associated with their family building and/or career management challenges.



Vision

Hiring for Hope aims to forge a mutually beneficial relationship between employers and three distinct groups whose disillusionment at their circumstances has resulted in a shared loss of hope: job seekers, couples experiencing a loss and/or obstacles to building their families, and their friends and family members.

Mission

We seek to ease the shared emotional, psychological and financial duress common during times of loss and crisis for job seekers, couples experiencing loss and/or obstacles to building their families, and their friends and family members. We aim to eliminate their feelings of hopelessness, isolation and shame, and replace them with renewed hope, opportunity and a sense of empowerment to control the outcome of their own destinies.

In short, we seek to reshape the way people and organizations think, talk, act and interact with each other about family building and career management issues. All of our services are focused on assisting and empowering individuals, families and organizations with their ability to build and sustain emotionally and financially viable careers, families and organizations.

Why These Groups?

A lack of insurance coverage for family building expenses in most states, coupled with a double-digit national unemployment rate, has created a situation where the basic dream of building a financially strong and sustainable life and family is becoming unviable.

In addition, the groups we serve share a common bond — one of isolation, loss, discouragement, and hopelessness. We believe, because of these commonalities, it makes sense to unite these highly motivated groups in a mutually beneficial networking relationship.










Our Unique Approach

Hiring for Hope Services

Our services for job seekers, couples, and their friends and family members are free, confidential, and compassionate. They simultaneously provide financial assistance, support, and career and family building management services to the populations we serve. In the process we also solve the workforce challenges of employers, and ease the emotional and psychological duress that is so commonly experienced by these groups during times of loss, crises, and transition.
